AGRICULTURAL RETURNS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND),
1939

The Ministry of Agriculture hereby gives notice that under Section 1(2) of the Agricultural Returns Act (Northern Ireland), 1939, every occupier of any agricultural land or the person having the management on behalf of the occupier of any agricultural land in Northern Ireland is required to furnish on demand by a member of the Royal Ulster Constabulary

authorised by the Ministry to act as an enumerator of Agricultural Statistics particulars of the utilization of land, area under crops, numbers of livestock and poultry, particulars of agricultural machinery, numbers of persons employed in agriculture, etc., on such land as at the prescribed day.

The "prescribed day" for the purposes of this return under the Act is the first day of June, 1950.
