The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that they have made an Order under Section 9 of the Finance Act, 1932, Section 7 of the Finance Act, 1934, and Section 1 of the Import Duties (Emergency Provisions) Act, 1939, viz.:—

The Import Duties (Drawback) (No. 2) Order, 1952, which increases the rate of drawback of customs duty paid on smokeless propellant powder

used in the manufacture of sporting cartridges from 3½d. a lb. to 9d. a lb.

The drawback previously allowed in respect of cartridge cases used in the manufacture of such cartridges is now obsolete and is discontinued by this Order, which comes into operation on the 8th February, 1952.
