The Clerk of the Council read a letter dated the 6th February, 1952, from Her Majesty's Privy Council and also the Accession Proclamation, a copy of which was transmitted therewith.

The Justices for the government of Northern Ireland and members of the Privy Council signified their approval to a Proclamation requiring all Mayors, Sheriffs and other His Majesty's Officers to publish and proclaim Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second.

A number of persons of quality who had been invited by Their Excellencies to be present were admitted to the Council Chamber.

The Justices for the government of Northern Ireland and members of the Privy Council signified their approval to a Proclamation acknowledging Queen Elizabeth the Second to be our only lawful and rightful Queen. The Proclamation thereafter lay on the table for signature by the other persons present.
