SUMMARY JURISDICTION Petty Sessions Districts and Times

Order, dated 27th July, 1955, made by the Ministry of Home Affairs, under Sub-section (1) of Section ten of the Summary Jurisdiction and Criminal Justice Act (Northern Ireland), 1935.

In pursuance of the provisions of sub-section (1) of section ten of the Summary Jurisdiction and Criminal Justice Act (Northern Ireland), 1935, the Ministry of Home Affairs, after consultation with the County Court Judge and Resident Magistrate concerned, hereby orders and directs that Petty Sessions for the Petty Sessions District of Sixmilecross, shall as and from the first day of September, 1955, be regularly held at Beragh, in the said Petty Sessions District, on the first Thursday in each month at 10.45 a.m. for Juvenile cases and at 11 a.m. for other business.

### GAME PRESERVATION ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1928

#### And Game Law Amendment Act (Northern Ireland), 1951

In pursuance of Section 7F of the Game Preservation Act (Northern Ireland), 1928, as inserted by Section 3 of the Game Law Amendment Act (Northern Ireland), 1951, notice is hereby given, that the Minister of Home Affairs proposes to make an Order under Section 7 of the Game Preservation Act (Northern Ireland), 1928, as amended by the said Act of 1951, prohibiting the sale or purchase of Partridge for a period of one year from the 1st day of October, next.
