BOOT AND SHOE REPAIRING WAGES COUNCIL (NORTHERN IRELAND)

The Boot and Shoe Repairing Wages Council (Northern Ireland) hereby gives notice of its intention to submit to the Ministry of Labour and National Insurance proposals for (1) increasing the statutory minimum remuneration set out in the Boot and Shoe Repairing Wages Council (Northern Ireland) Wages Regulation Order, 1951 (Order N.I.B.S. (67)) (S.R. & O. (N.I.) 1951, No. 217), as amended by the Boot and Shoe Repairing Wages Council (Northern Ireland) Wages Regulation (Amendment) Order, 1955 (Order N.I.B.S. (73)) (S.R. & O. (N.I.) 1955, No. 18) and (2) the revocation of Order N.I.B.S. (73).

Particulars of the proposals may be obtained from the Secretary of the Wages Council at the address given below.

The Wages Council will consider any written representations with respect to the above-mentioned proposals which may be sent to it within twenty-one days from 10th February, 1956. It is desirable that persons making objections should state the precise nature of their objections.
