NOTE.—The following diseases have not appeared in Northern Ireland since the year shown after each disease:— Rinderpest (Pestis Bovina), 1877; Pleuro-Pneumonia (Peripneumonia contagiosa bovum), 1893; Sheep Fox (Variola ovium), 1850; Rabies (Rage), 1923; and Glanders (including Farcy) (Malleus), 1910; Epizootic Lymphangitis (Lymphangitis Epizootica) and Dourine have never existed in Northern Ireland.
