**BY THE GOVERNOR OF NORTHERN

WAKEHURST**

WHEREAS by Sub-Section (5) of Section 2 of the National Assistance Act (Northern Ireland), 1948, it is provided that the constitution and proceedings of the National Assistance Board for Northern Ireland shall be governed by the provisions set out in the First Schedule to that Act :

And Whereas by the said First Schedule it is provided that the National Assistance Board for Northern Ireland shall consist of a Chairman and not less than one nor more than four other members appointed by the Governor of Northern Ireland :

And Whereas the term of office of the several members of the Board as constituted will terminate on 30th June, 1959 :

Now, therefore, I, John de Vere, Baron Wakehurst, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor of Northern Ireland, do hereby, in pursuance of the aforesaid provisions of the National Assistance Act

(Northern Ireland), 1948, appoint Sir Percival Brown, C.B.E., to be Chairman of the said Board from the 1st July, 1959, until the 30th June, 1960, and Henry Burdge, Esquire, O.B.E., J.P., Mrs. Martha Ringland Collis, and Robert Heggarty Coulter, Esquire, to be members of the said Board from the 1st July, 1959, until the 30th June, 1960.

Given at Government House, Hillsborough this 2nd day of June in the year one thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine.

COLONIAL STOCK ACTS, 1877 TO 1948

ADDITION TO LIST OF STOCKS UNDER SECTION 2 OF THE COLONIAL STOCK ACT, 1900 (63 & 64 Vic., Cap. 62)

PURSUANT to Section 2 of the Colonial Stock Act, 1900, the Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that the provisions of the Act have been complied with in respect of the undermentioned Stock registered or inscribed in the United Kingdom :—

Union of South Africa 5½% Registered Stock 1974/76.
