CIVIL AUTHORITIES (SPECIAL POWERS)
ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1922 TO 1943

WHEREAS by Regulation 8 of the regulations to which the Civil Authorities (Special Powers) Acts (Northern Ireland), 1922 to 1943, apply (being a regulation made by the Minister of Home Affairs and having effect and to be enforced in like manner as regulations contained in the Schedule to the Civil Authorities (Special Powers) Act (Northern Ireland), 1922) it is provided that if it appears to the Minister of Home Affairs that the publication or continued publication of any newspapers, periodical, book, circular or other printed matter is prejudicial to or likely to be prejudicial to the preservation of the peace and the maintenance of order in Northern Ireland, the said Minister may by order prohibit for any specified period the publication of any such newspaper, periodical, book, circular or other printed matter:

And Whereas it is further provided by the said Regulation that if any person shall, within such specified period, print, publish, circulate or distribute or be in any way concerned in the printing, publication, circulation or distribution of any newspaper, periodical, book, circular or other printed matter, the publication of which has been prohibited under the said Regulation, he shall be guilty of an offence against the regulations to which the aforesaid Acts apply:

And Whereas it appears to me, the said Minister, that the publication or continued publication of the newspapers and printed matter hereafter in this order specified is prejudicial to or likely to be prejudicial to the preservation of the peace and the maintenance of order in Northern Ireland:

Now, therefore, I, The Right Honourable Brian Faulkner, M.P., Minister of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers vested in me by the Civil Authorities (Special Powers) Acts (Northern Ireland), 1922 to 1943, and the said Regulation 8, and of all other powers enabling me in this behalf, do hereby order that the publication and distribution of the newspapers entitled—

"THE UNITED IRISHMAN"

"RESURGENT ULSTER"

"GAIR ULADH"

"GLOR ULADH"

and the printed matter entitled—

"THE IRISH REPUBLICAN BULLETIN"

TRUNK ROAD IMPROVEMENT AT BRUSLEE, CO. ANTRIM

On 26th February and 5th March, 1959, the Ministry gave notice that it proposed to construct five lengths of new road in substitution for the corresponding lengths of the existing Belfast-Larne Trunk Road in the townlands of Carnall, Lisnalinchy, Bruslee, Little Ballymena, Skilganaban, Legaloy and Dunturky and to make an Order under Section 1 of the Roads Act (Northern Ireland), 1948, the effect of which would be to provide that the lengths of new road would become parts of the trunk road and that after completion of the new lengths the corresponding lengths of the existing road would cease to form part of the Trunk Road.

The Ministry has amended its proposals so far as they relate to the length of new road in the townlands of Skilganaban and Legaloy and in consequence that length of new road will not now be constructed. Improvement will, instead, be carried out to the existing trunk road in these townlands. The Ministry accordingly gives notice that it proposes to modify the proposed Order by the omission of any reference to the said length of new road, but the proposals with regard to the other four lengths of new road are unchanged.

BELFAST-BANGOR TRUNK ROAD SYDENHAM BY-PASS
