REGISTRY OF DEEDS

REGISTRATION OF COUNTY COURT PROCEEDINGS AS LITES PENDENTES

Regulations, dated 13th May, 1960, made by the Ministry of Finance under Section 35 of the Registry of Deeds (Ireland) Act, 1832(a), as applied by Section 56 of the County Courts Act (Northern Ireland), 1959(b).

In pursuance of Section 35 of the Registry of Deeds (Ireland) Act, 1832(a), as applied by Section 56 of the County Courts Act (Northern Ireland), 1959(b), the Ministry of Finance hereby makes the following Regulations.

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Registry of Deeds (Registration of County Court Proceedings as Lites Pendentes) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1960.

Registration

2. Any proceedings in the County Court to affect unregistered land may be registered in the Registry of Deeds as a lis pendens by the lodgment on a memorial in the form prescribed in Part 1 of the Schedule.

Vacation of Registration

3. Any such registration may be vacated by the
