lodgment of a certificate in the form prescribed in Part II of the Schedule. Upon receipt of such cer-tificate the Registrar shall make or cause to be made in the records of the Registry a memorandum in accordance with the terms of such certificate and thereafter this memorandum shall be recorded on any certificate of search on which reference to the corresponding memorial under Regulation 2 shall appear.

Certification

4. A memorial or certificate for the purpose of these Regulations shall be certified by the Clerk of the Crown and Peace for the Court in which the said proceedings are entered.

Fees

5. The fee payable on a memorial shall be as prescribed in Sub-section (1) of Section 4 of the Registration of Deeds (Amendment) Act (Northern Ireland), 1957(c). A fee of five shillings shall be payable upon any certificate lodged under Regulation 4 tion 4.

URBAN DRAINAGE

RURAL DISTRICT OF CASTLEREAGH

Order, dated 4th day of May, 1960, made by the Ministry of Agriculture under Section 20(1) of the Urban Drainage Act (Northern Ireland), 1957(a). WHEREAS it appears to the Ministry of Agriculture (hereinafter called "the Ministry") that the density of buildings in that part of the Rural Dis-trict of Castlereagh hereinafter referred to is such as to justify that part of the said rural district being designated an urban area for the purposes of the Urban Drainage Act (Northern Ireland), 1957 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act").

Now, therefore, the Ministry in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Sub-section (1) of Section twenty of the Act hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Castlereagh Rural District (Designation of Urban Drainage Area) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland), 1960, and shall come into operation on the date hereof.
