The Ministry of Health and Local Government for Northern Ireland hereby gives notice that the Ministry has instructed Mr. Robert Lowry, Q.C., to hold an Inquiry with the following Terms of Reference:—

"To inquire into the observance of the existing law, including Belfast Local Acts, with regard to members of the Belfast Corporation voting or taking part in discussion on matters in which they have a direct or indirect pecuniary interest or in which they have acted professionally or in using knowledge which they have acquired through their membership of the Corporation for their personal advantage and to consider whether the existing law on the subject is adequate or requires amendment."

ROADS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1948

The Ministry of Commerce hereby gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under section 17 of the Roads Act (Northern Ireland), 1948, the effect of which will be to authorise the abandonment of approximately 428 lineal yards of unclassified road "Molly Lane" in the townland of Foughillotra, and of approximately 950 lineal yards of road in Ballinliss townland in Newry No. 2 Rural District in the County of Armagh.

The lengths of roads proposed to be abandoned are delineated on Map No. R.A.S. 17/45, a copy of which, together with a copy of the proposed Order, may be inspected by any person free of charge at all reasonable hours during the period of forty days from the 12th day of May, 1961, at any of the undermentioned places:—
