

POST OFFICE TELEPHONES

Her Majesty's Postmaster General hereby gives notice in accordance with paragraph (5) of Regulation 35 and paragraph (3) of Regulation 29 of the Telephone Regulations, 1960.

1. that the call charge payable for a transferred charge telephone call which is established to the United Kingdom or the Isle of Man from the Country mentioned in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall be that set out in Column 2 of the said Schedule.
2. that the service charge payable where a person making a call from the United Kingdom or the Isle of Man to the Country mentioned in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto, requests that the call charge should be reversed but
 - a. the call is not established (whether or not consent to such request has been obtained from the person answering on the called telephone) or
 - b. such consent is not obtained and the call is established as an ordinary call shall be that set out in Column 3 of the said Schedule.

In case (b) the service charge is in addition to the charge in respect of the call payable under the Telephone Regulations, 1960.

PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT OF DRAINAGE CANAL FROM SOUTH STREET TO FLOOD GATES

In pursuance of the provisions of Section 4 of the Urban Drainage Act (N.I.), 1957, the Newtownards Borough Council hereby gives notice that a draft Urban Drainage Scheme has been prepared

for the relief of flooding of lands at Greenwell Street and Old Shore Road, Newtownards, and to provide for the adequate reception and discharge to the sea of all waters flowing into the Drainage Canal.
