NORTHERN IRELAND LAND ACT, 1925.

NOTICE is hereby given, that in accordance with the requirements of Section 17 (8) of the above Act the Land Purchase Commission has, with the assent of the Treasury, settled the amount or scale of remuneration to be payable to such person as may be nominated by the Owner with the approval of the Commission for the purpose of furnishing the particulars, etc., required for the purpose of Section 17 of the Act, at a sum calculated at the rate of 3% on the amount of the purchase money of the Estate and payable out of such purchase money as provided by the said Act.

The "purchase money" means the purchase money advanced and does not include the "Bonus" payable under the said Act.
