REGULATIONS, 1954

Whereas the Therapeutic Substances (Supply of Antibiotics for Agricultural Purposes) Regulations, 1953, and the Therapeutic Substances (Supply of Oxytetracycline for Agricultural Purposes) Regulations, 1954, having effect by virtue of the Therapeutic Substances Act, 1956, provide that aureomycin supplement, penicillin supplement and oxytetracycline supplement shall not be sold or supplied otherwise than in a container bearing a label containing in such manner as the Minister of Agriculture for Northern Ireland may require, certain particulars, including such particulars with respect to the storage and use of the supplement as he may require:—

Now therefore I, The Right Honourable Henry William West the Minister of Agriculture for Northern Ireland, hereby require (except in any case in which I impose any other requirement), (1) that the aforesaid particulars shall appear on the container label in the manner set out in the Schedule hereto; and (2) that the said particulars shall include the particulars with respect to the storage and use of the supplement set out in the said Schedule.
