ROYAL ASSENT TO BILLS

The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that They have made an Order under Sections 9 and 13 of, and Schedule 5 to, the Import Duties Act, 1958.

Viz.—The Import Duty Drawbacks (No. 3) Order 1965.

This Order varies the rates of drawback of import duty on:

- (i) certain imported hazelnuts used in the manufacture for export of specified hazelnut products, and
- (ii) certain imported square sawn wood and timber and imported wooden veneer sheets used in the manufacture for export of specified sewing machine woodwork.

The Order comes into operation on the 7th April, 1965, and has been published as Statutory Instruments 1965, No. 699.
