

I, David Bowman, being an authorised officer for the purpose of the Imported Livestock Order, 1958, hereby give notice that on the 29th day of July, 1965, at or in the vicinity of Killeen, Fyfin, the undermentioned 1 livestock was seized in accordance with the provisions of the said Order.

Any person claiming that the livestock was at the time of seizure his property and either

- (a) that it was not imported, removed or brought into the United Kingdom from the Channel Islands, or the Isle of Man or the Republic of Ireland, or
- (b) that it was not so imported, removed or brought in in contravention of the said Order, may give notice in writing to that effect to the Head or other Constable at Castleberg, Co. Tyrone, such notice to be received within 21 days of the date of seizure, or, where notice of the seizure is published in the Belfast Gazette, within ten days of such publication, whichever period shall terminate the later.

If no such claim is received as aforesaid the said Order provides that the livestock shall be deemed to be condemned as forfeited.

Vehicle or Container

I, Charles Fergus Simpson, being an authorised officer for the purpose of the Imported Livestock Order, 1958, hereby give notice that on the 28th day of July, 1965, at or in the vicinity of Hill Street, Newry, the undermentioned vehicle or container was seized in accordance with the provisions of the said Order. Any person claiming that the vehicle or container was at the time of seizure his property and that it was not used for the carriage, handling or concealment of livestock imported, removed or brought into the United Kingdom from the Channel Islands or the Isle of Man or the Republic of Ireland in contravention of the said Order, may give notice in writing to that effect to the Head Constable or other Constable at Bessbrook R.U.C. Station, such notice to be received within 21 days of the date of seizure, or, where notice of the seizure is published in the Belfast Gazette within ten days of such publication, whichever period shall terminate the later.

If no such claim is received as aforesaid the said Order provides that the vehicle or container shall be deemed to be condemned as forfeited.
