### OVERSEAS TELEGRAMS

Her Majesty's Postmaster General hereby gives notice, in accordance with Regulations 8 (2) and (3) and 30 (6) of the Telegraph (British Commonwealth and Foreign Written Telegram) Regulations, 1959, also Regulation 6 of the Telegraph (British Commonwealth and Foreign Written Press Tele-

gram) Regulations, 1959, that with effect from 1st October, 1965, and until further notice, the rates of charge for telegrams from the United Kingdom, the Isle of Man and the Channel Islands on the one hand to China (Mainland), Liberia and Togo on the other hand will be as follows:

### TELEPHONES

*Transferred charge calls from Lebanon to United Kingdom*

Her Majesty's Postmaster General hereby gives notice in accordance with paragraph (5) of Regulation 31 and paragraph (3) of Regulation 25 of the Telephone Regulations 1965 that until further notice:

- the call charges payable for a transferred charge telephone call which is established to the United Kingdom or the Isle of Man from the country mentioned in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto provided shall be those set out in Column 2 of the said Schedule;
- the service charges payable where a person making a call from the United Kingdom or the Isle of Man to the country mentioned in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto provided, requests that the call charge should be reversed but
  - the call is not established (whether or not consent to such request has been obtained from the person answering on the called telephone) or
  - such consent is not obtained and the call is established as an ordinary call shall be those set out in Column 3 of the said Schedule.

In case (b) the service charge is in addition to the charge in respect of the call payable under the Telephone Regulations, 1965.
