COPYRIGHT ACT, 1956 PERFORMING RIGHT TRIBUNAL

The originator alleges that, in the light of a survey of related tariffs and of the current value of copyright music to promoters of popular concerts, a revision of the basis of assessment of royalties is now appropriate, and proposals are made with this object.
