## RESALE PRICES ACT 1964

*List No. 3 of classes of goods the subject of  
declarations by the Restrictive Practices  
Court under Section 5*

The Registrar of Restrictive Trading agreements in pursuance of subsection (5) of Section 6 of the Resale Prices Act 1964 hereby publishes the following list of classes of goods in respect of which the Restrictive Practices Court has refused to make an Order directing that they shall be exempted goods for the purposes of the Act.

In this list "the Brussels Nomenclature" means the Convention on Nomenclature for the Classification of Goods in Customs Tariffs (Crmd. 1070).

This list includes all classes of goods in respect of which the Court has made declarations up to 31st December, 1966; classes in relation to which the date of declaration is shown as 28th July, 1966, or earlier also appeared in List 2.
