NOTICE is hereby given in pursuance of Section 3 (3) of the Public Health Acts Amendment Act, 1907, that the Right Honourable Sir Richard Dawson Bates, the Minister of

Home Affairs for Northern Ireland has, in pursuance of the powers vested in him by the said Section 3 of the Act, the Government of Ireland Act, 1920, and all other powers in that behalf enabling him, made an Order declaring Part VII of the Act to be in force in the Strabane Urban District as from the 1st day of May, 1926.
