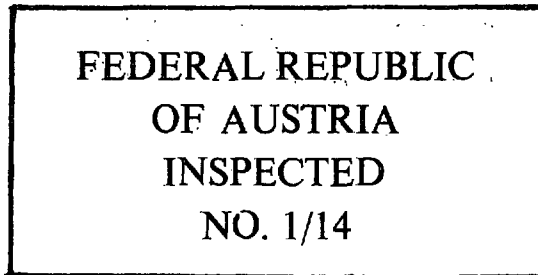

Argentine Republic: Official Certificate

The Ministry of Health and Social Services with the approval of the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food gives notice that in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Imported Food (Northern Ireland) Regulations 1968 it hereby varies the recognition of the Official Certificates reproduced in 1 and 2 of Part I of the Schedule to the Notice published in the London Gazette dated 15th March, 1938, and in the Belfast Gazette dated 8th April, 1938, design 2 in the Schedule to the Notice published in the London Gazette dated 11th March, 1952, and in the Belfast Gazette dated 18th July, 1952, and designs 1, 2 and 3 in the Schedule to the Notice published in the London Gazette dated 7th July, 1964, for the importation of meat and meat products; and the Official Certificates reproduced in the First Schedule to the Notice published in the Belfast Gazette dated 1st November, 1968, for the importation of horsemeat and horsemeat products into Northern Ireland from the Argentine Republic, to the extent shown in the Schedule hereto.

The Notice published in the London Gazette dated 15th September, 1967, and the list of establishment numbers shown in the Second Schedule to the Notice in the Belfast Gazette dated 1st November, 1968, are hereby revoked.

Italy: Official Certificate
