SEIZURE NOTICE

THE IMPORTED LIVESTOCK ORDER, 1958

I, Thomas Starrett, Constable, being an authorised officer for the purpose of the Imported Livestock Order, 1958, hereby give notice that on the Sixth day of January, 1969, at or in the vicinity of F.M.C. Abattoir, Warrenpoint Road, Newry, the under-mentioned One (1) livestock was seized in accordance with the provisions of the said Order.

Any person claiming that the livestock was at the time of seizure his property and either
