Italy : Official Certificate

The Ministry of Health and Social Services with the approval of the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food gives notice that in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Imported Food (Northern Ireland) Regulations 1968 it hereby varies the recognition of the Official Certificate reproduced in Part I of the Schedule to the Notice published in the London Gazette dated 1st December, 1967, for the importation of meat and meat products into Northern Ireland from Italy, to the extent shown in the Schedule hereto.
