PRICES AND INCOMES ACT 1966

Wages and conditions in the Electrical Contracting Industry

DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5(4) EXTENDING THE PERIOD WITHIN WHICH THE NATIONAL BOARD FOR PRICES AND INCOMES MUST PUBLISH THEIR REPORT

1. Whereas the First Secretary of State and Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity, in pur-suance of her powers under section 2(1) of the Prices and Incomes Act 1966, referred the above-mentioned question to the National Board for Prices and In-comes for examination and has published the text of the reference in the Gazette on 13th December 1968;

2. And whereas by section 5(3) of the Act, but subject to section 5(4), the Board are required to make their report so as to allow publication within three months of the said date;

3. Now, therefore, the First Secretary of State and Secretary of State for Employment and Productivity, in pursuance of her powers under the said section 5(4), hereby directs that the said period of three months be extended by three months.
