MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS

The Ministry of Home Affairs has made Regulations under Part IV of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act (N.I.) 1934, Part IV and Section 66 of the Road Traffic Act (N.I.) 1955, Article 8 of the Visiting Forces (Application of Law) Order 1954 as amended by the Visiting Forces (Application of Law) Order 1956, Article 4 of the Motor Vehicles (International Circulation) (Road Traffic) (N.I.) Order 1957 and Section 14 of the Road Traffic Act (N.I.) 1968 entitled the Road Vehicles Lighting Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1969 (S.R. & O. 1969, No. 214). The Regulations consolidate with amendment the existing law on the subject, the principal changes being:

- (1) Most vehicles having four or more wheels are required to carry two headlamps;
- (2) Passenger vehicles constructed solely for the carriage of passengers and their effects and adapted to carry more than 7 passengers exclusive of the driver, and goods vehicles, the unladen weight of which exceeds 2 tons, must permanently display the required lights when parked during the hours of darkness.

The Regulations come into operation on 1st October, 1969, and copies may be obtained from Her Majesty's Stationery Office, 7-11 Linenhall Street, Belfast BT2 8AY, or through any bookseller.
