RESTRICTION ON INSURANCE COMPANY

The Ministry of Commerce has issued a direction under section 11(1) of the Insurance Companies Act (Northern Ireland) 1968 to Midland Northern and Scottish Insurance Company Limited that it shall cease taking on new motor vehicle insurance business in Northern Ireland as from 6th August, 1970.

This prohibition applies to renewal and variation of existing policies as well as to issue of new policies. It does not prevent the Company discharging its liabilities under policies already in issue.

THE MONEYLENDERS ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1900 to 1969

Order of Exemption
