

## POST OFFICE TELECOMMUNICATIONS CHARGES NOTICE E1/1971

- 1 TELEPHONE CALLS (EXCEPT DATEL CALLS) FROM THE UNITED KINGDOM OR THE ISLE OF MAN TO NEW ZEALAND.
- 2 TRANSFERRED CHARGE TELEPHONE CALLS FROM NEW ZEALAND TO THE UNITED KINGDOM OR THE ISLE OF MAN.
- 3 CREDIT CARD TELEPHONE CALLS FROM NEW ZEALAND TO THE UNITED KINGDOM OR THE ISLE OF MAN.

1 The Post Office hereby gives notice pursuant to regulation 21(2) and regulation 26(3) of the Telephone Regulations 1968 (which have effect under paragraph 3(1) of schedule 9 to the Post Office Act 1969 as if they were provisions of a Scheme made under section 28 of that Act) that on and from 11th January, 1971 the charges for telephone calls (except Datel calls) from the United Kingdom or the Isle of Man to New Zealand will be as shown in columns 2 to 4 of the said Schedule; the charges for the personal call facility in relation to such calls will be as shown in column 4 of the Schedule to this Notice. These charges have been fixed by the Post Office in accordance with regulation 21(1)(a) and regulation 26(3) of the said regulations and may be revised at any time by the Post Office.

2 The Post Office hereby further gives notice pursuant to regulation 32(5) of the said regulations that on and from 11th January, 1971 the charges for transferred charge calls made from New Zealand when the person answering a called telephone in the United Kingdom or the Isle of Man consents to the call charges being reversed will be as shown in columns 5 and 6 of the Schedule to this Notice. These charges have been fixed by the Post Office in accordance with Regulation 32(3)(a) of the said Regulations and may be revised at any time by the Post Office.

3 The Post Office hereby further gives notice pursuant to regulation 33(7) of the said regulations that on and from 11th January, 1971 the charges for credit card calls made from telephones on the telephone systems of Authorities providing service in New Zealand to any telephone in the British Islands will be as shown in columns 7 to 9 of the said Schedule. These charges have been fixed by the Post Office in accordance with regulation 33(6)(b) of the said regulations and may be revised at any time by the Post Office.
