## MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS

Notice is hereby given that the Ministry of Home Affairs, in exercise of its powers under Section 1 of the Consumer Protection Act (Northern Ireland) 1965, has made regulations dated 16th July, 1971, entitled the Cooking Utensils (Safety) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1971 (S.R. & O. (N.I.) 1971, No. 333).

In order to prevent or reduce risk of death or personal injury, the Regulations, which come into operation on 1st December, 1971, impose certain requirements in relation to kitchen utensils in which to cook food and accordingly under the Act, subject to certain exceptions, no person may sell or have in his possession for sale a utensil not complying with the Regulations.

Regulation 3 prescribes a limit of 0.2 per cent for the lead content of any tin or other metallic coating used on any surface of the utensil designed to come in contact with the food.

Regulation 4 provides that goods shall be subject to the Regulations notwithstanding that they were manufactured before the coming into operation of the Regulations.

The Regulations, which come into operation on 1st December, 1971, require:

- (a) Shot-firers to be licensed by the Ministry of Home Affairs;
- (b) A Register showing explosives received, used or disposed of to be kept at all mines and quarries whether or not the mine or quarry has an explosives store; and
- (c) Amend Form 8 in the Schedule to the Explosives Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1970.

The Ministry of Home Affairs has made Regulations under Sections 114 and 141 of the Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland) 1970 entitled the Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland) 1970 (Date of Commencement) Order (Northern Ireland) 1971 S.R. & O. No. 331.

This Order brings into operation Sections 114 and 141 of the Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland) 1970. This will enable the Ministry to make Regulations to require both motor cyclists and their passengers to wear approved headgear and to prohibit the sale of unapproved headgear.
