Imports of meat and meat products (including poultry meat) into Northern Ireland are restricted or prohibited under Diseases of Animals legislation by the Department of Agriculture and applications for such importations must be made to that Department. Official Certificates for public health purposes in accordance with the Imported Food (Northern Ireland) Regulations, 1968, do not confer any exemption from these restrictions or prohibitions.

Sweden: Official Certificate

The Department of Health and Social Services with the approval of the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food gives notice that in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Imported Food (Northern Ireland) Regulations 1968 it hereby restricts recognition of the Official Certificate reproduced in the First Schedule to the Notice published in the Belfast Gazette dated 24th January, 1969, for the importation of meat and meat products into Northern Ireland from Sweden, to the extent shown in the Schedule hereto.

The Notice published in the Belfast Gazette dated 10th August, 1973, is hereby revoked.
