The Scheme, which will come into operation on 24th June 1974, provides for new charges for letters, registered letters, parcels and various services.

THE POST OFFICE INLAND POST AMENDMENT (NO. 5) SCHEME 1974

Made

31st May, 1974

Coming into Operation 24th June, 1974

The Post Office, by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by section 28 of the Post Office Act 1969, and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, hereby makes the following Scheme:

Commencement, citation and interpretation

- 1.—(1) This Scheme shall come into operation on 24th June, 1974, and may be cited as the Post Office Inland Post Amendment (No. 5) Scheme 1974.
- (2) This Scheme shall be read as one with the Post Office Inland Post Scheme 1972 (Post Office Scheme P7/1972) (hereinafter called "the Scheme") as amended by the Post Office Inland Post Amendment (No. 1) Scheme 1973 (Post Office Scheme P1/1973), the Post Office Inland Post Amendment (No. 2) Scheme 1973 (Post Office Scheme P10/1973), the Post Office Inland Post Amendment (No. 3) Scheme 1973 (Post Office Scheme P11/1973) and the Post Office Inland Post Amendment (No. 4) Scheme 1973 (Post Office Scheme P12/1973).
- (3) The Interpretation Act 1889 applies for the interpretation of this Scheme as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament and as if this Scheme were an Act of Parliament.

Rates of postage and other charges and fees

- 2.—(1) The following amendments are made to the Scheme:
  - a. In paragraph 6(2) for the amount " $7\frac{1}{2}$ p" there shall be substituted "10p".
  - b. In paragraph 30(8) for the amount "£5" there shall be substituted "£10". In the case of a licence granted before the day on which this Scheme comes into operation, the first annual fee under paragraph 30(8) of the Scheme shall be due and payable on the relevant anniversary falling on or next after that day, without prejudice to the right of the Post Office to recover from the licensee the amount of any fee due or payable before that day under the provisions of the Scheme which remains unpaid.
