These regulations provide for the valuation of the assets of insurance companies for the purposes of provisions in the Insurance Companies Act (Northern Ireland) 1968 and the Insurance Companies Amendment Act 1973 which require the value of such assets to be determined in accordance with valuation regulations. Except for certain assets to which benefits payable under insurance policies are linked, the regulations apply to all general business assets and to all long term business assets.
