Proposed Bye-Laws

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to paragraph 3 of Schedule 4 of the Drainage (Northern Ireland) Order 1973 that certain significant alterations have been made to the Draft Lough Erne Bye-Laws published in December 1974. The effect of the said alterations is:

1. to provide for the Bye-laws to come into operation on the 1st day of November, 1975;
2. to provide for the carrying by private vessels (the term vessels in this Notice means craft propelled by an engine in excess of 7 shp) of fire extinguishing equipment, and to set out conditions relative to the siting and housing of gas cylinders and ancillary equipment on such vessels;
3. to require all vessels using the navigation to be fitted with a good and efficient means of reversing;
4. to provide for the display of lights by vessels navigating between sunset and sunrise;
5. to set out detailed requirements relative to the size, colour and display of identification numbers on all vessels.

6. to set out the application forms which will be used for:
 - (a) licensing of hire vessels and
 - (b) registration of private vessels
7. to make changes in the location and limits of areas of water on which speed limits will apply.
