CONSUMER PROTECTION ACT (NORTHERN  
IRELAND) 1965

The Department of Commerce hereby gives notice that it has made regulations entitled the Heating Appliances (Fireguards) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1975 (S.R. 1975 No. 310).

These regulations revoke the Heating Appliances (Fireguards) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1953.

The regulations impose requirements to prevent or reduce risk of death or personal injury in relation to fireguards for gas and electric fires and oil heaters.

Subject to certain exceptions, no person may sell or have in his possession for sale such an appliance not complying with the regulations, which come into operation on 1st January, 1976.
