WEIGHTS AND MEASURES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1967

The Department of Commerce hereby gives notice that it

has made an Order entitled the Weights and Measures (Biscuits and Shortbread) Order (Northern Ireland) 1976 (S.R. 1976 No. 198).

The Order provides that Part XI of Schedule 2 to the Weights and Measures Act (Northern Ireland) 1967 shall cease to apply to biscuits and shortbread on 1st January, 1978, when the provisions of that Part are replaced by those of this Order.

The Order provides that Part IX of Schedule 2 to the Weights & Measures Act (Northern Ireland) 1967 shall cease to apply to dried fruits, that is apples (including dried apple rings), apricots, currants, dates, figs, muscatels, nectarines, peaches, pears (including dried pear rings), prunes, raisins and sultanas and dried fruit salad on 1st January, 1977, when the provisions of that Part are replaced by those of this Order.

Notice is hereby given that the Department of Health and Social Services in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 7 and 68 of the Food and Drugs Act (Northern Ireland) 1958 has made regulations entitled the Labelling of Food (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1970 (S.R.&O. 1970 No. 80).

The amendments to the definitions in the 1970 regulations will allow fresh fruit and vegetables and flour confectionery in certain limited types of packaging to be treated as exempt from labelling requirements. Other amendments are to those parts of the 1970 regulations which deal with the use as appropriate designations of names laid down in compositional regulations; claims made in relation to diabetic foods, the declaration of additives in

foods present as ingredients of other foods, fish names and generic terms.
