NORTHERN IRELAND ORDERS IN COUNCIL

The following Order has been made and is now available at H.M.S.O.:

The Industrial Relations (No. 2) (Northern Ireland) Order 1976. 1976 No. 2147 (N.I. 28). Price 75p net.

This Order confers rights on certain employees in relation to guarantee payments, suspension on medical grounds, maternity, trade union membership and activities, time off work, the insolvency of an employer, itemised pay statements and terms and conditions of employment and provides remedies for breach of those rights.

The Order also provides for the disclosure to trade union representatives by employers of certain information for the purpose of collective bargaining and requires the Labour Relations Agency to issue Codes of Practice in relation to the conduct of industrial relations.

These regulations, which implement Council Directive 74/409/E.E.C. on the harmonisation of the laws of Member States on honey,

- (a) define and lay down compositional requirements for the various types of honey;
- (b) reserve the word 'honey'; and certain expressions containing that word, for honey and the types of honey as defined by the regulations;
- (c) require the name 'honey' amplified in certain cases by specified qualifications to be applied to the product when traded;
- (d) specify how honey is to be labelled;
- (e) make consequential amendments to the labelling of Food Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1970 (S.R. & O. (N.I.) 1970 No. 80), as amended.

The regulations will come into force on 1st May, 1977, except for regulations 2 and 13 which come into force on 14th February, 1977, to enable products which comply with the remainder of the regulations to be sold from that date.
