DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE

HARBOURS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1970

Notice is hereby given in pursuance of Section 1(8) of the Harbours Act (Northern Ireland) 1970 that the Department of Commerce has made a Harbour Order entitled the Londonderry Port and Harbour Commissioners Acts (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 1976 (S.R. (N.I.) 1976 No. 389). This Order has been laid before Parliament under Paragraph 3(3) of Schedule I to the Northern Ireland Act 1974.

The Order amends the Londonderry Port and Harbour Acts 1854 to 1920 in relation to the constitution of the Londonderry Port and Harbour Commissioners. It provides

for the appointment of the Commissioners by the Head of the Department of Commerce and lays down certain qualifications for appointment.

DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES

Notice is hereby given that the Department of Health and Social Services in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 20, 29(1), 68 and 68A of the Food and Drugs Act (Northern Ireland) 1958 as amended by the European Communities (Food and Drugs) Order (Northern Ireland) 1972, has made regulations entitled (Drinking Milk Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1977 (S.R. 1977 No. 8).

The regulations provide for the execution and enforcement in Northern Ireland of the provisions of EEC Regulation No. 1411/71, as amended by EEC Regulation No. 566/76 and come into operation on 21st February, 1977.

The regulations restrict the types of milk which may be delivered to consumers to the following categories of drinking milk:

- (a) raw milk.
- (b) non-standardized whole milk produced in Northern Ireland with its composition unaltered since the milking stage but subject to a minimum fat content of 3.00 per cent fat;
- (c) standardized whole milk imported from other Member States, with a fat content of not less than the guideline figure fixed by the Council of the European Communities, equivalent to the weighted average fat content of whole milk produced and marketed in the United Kingdom during the previous year;
- (d) semi-skimmed milk with a fat content of at least 1.50 per cent and not more than 1.80 per cent;
- (e) skimmed milk with a fat content of not more than 0.30 per cent.

The guideline figure applicable to imported standardized whole milk for the milk year ending March 31st, 1977, has been fixed by EEC Regulation No. 2413/76 at 3.76 per cent fat.

The regulations will allow the continued sale of home produced whole milk with its natural fat content unchanged, but subject in future to absolute minimum fat content of 3.00 per cent. The only permitted alterations to the composition of drinking milk will be those necessary for the production of semi-skimmed or skimmed milk. Provision is made for the labelling of imported standardized whole milk and for records of transactions in such milk to be maintained. The regulations will not apply to milk intended for exportation to any place outside the United Kingdom. Penalties are laid down for contraventions and enforcement will be the responsibility of district councils.

CHILD BENEFIT (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER 1975

VALUE ADDED TAX

Treasury Directions dated 30th December, 1976, under Section 19(2) and (3) of the Finance Act 1972 as to the Supply of Goods and Services by Government Departments

(These Directions amend the Treasury Directions given under section 19(2) and (3) of the Finance Act, 1972, dated 11th November, 1975, and published in the Belfast Gazettes of Friday, 21st November, 1975, and Friday, 5th December, 1975).

The Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 19(2) and (3) of the Finance Act, 1972(a), hereby direct as follows:

1. These directions shall come into operation on 1st January, 1977.

2. In these directions:

"the directions" mean the Treasury directions given under section 19(2) and (3) of the Finance Act, 1972, dated 11th November, 1975;

"the Schedules" mean the Schedules to the directions; and

"column (1)" and "column (2)" respectively mean column (1) and column (2) of the Schedules.

3. Subparagraph (b)(i) of paragraph 3 of the directions shall be deleted and the following shall be substituted therefor:

(i) out of the appropriate National Insurance Funds under section 85 of the National Insurance Act 1965 (b) and section 135 of the Social Security Act 1975 (c) or under section 83 of the National Insurance Act (Northern Ireland) 1966 (1966c.6(N.I.)) and section 129 of the Social Security (Northern Ireland) Act 1975 (1975c.15) or".

4. Column (1) and column (2) of the Schedules, specified in the left hand column of the table to this paragraph, shall be amended respectively in accordance with the instructions contained in the middle and right hand columns of the table.
