## DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE

### AGRICULTURAL RETURNS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1939

Under Section 1 (1) of the above-mentioned Act every person occupying agricultural land and/or owning livestock is required to furnish to the Department of Agriculture on demand returns showing certain particulars in respect of the land and/or livestock as on prescribed days.

The Department hereby gives notice that a return under the Act will be required as on 1st April, 1977.

## DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE

Notice is hereby given that the Department of Commerce has made a statutory rule entitled the Prevention of Fraud (Investments) Act Licensing (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1977 which comes into operation on 1st April, 1977. (S.R. (N.I.) 1977 No. 35).

The regulations increase the fees payable for a principal's licence and for a representative's licence. The fee payable on the amendment of a principal's licence is abolished.

The grant of a licence to a principal or to a representative, that is, to a servant or agent of a principal, authorises the licensee to carry on the business of dealing in securities.

Whereas the sum of £75.67 is recoverable on foot of a judgment of the County Court for the Division of County Borough of Belfast dated 27th April, 1976, in favour of A. & C. Electric Limited of 56 Dublin Road, Belfast, the creditor, against Patterson & Chambers Limited of 1A Madison Avenue East, Belfast, and 50A Holywood Road, Belfast, the debtor.

And whereas on 27th October, 1976, Certificates of Unenforceability were issued.

It is ordered that the said Certificates of Unenforceability be and the same are hereby discharged.
