Notice is hereby given that the Department of Health and Social Services in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Sections 4, 7, 68 and 68A of the Food and Drugs Act (Northern Ireland) 1958 has made Regulations entitled—

CONDENSED MILK AND DRIED MILK REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1977 (S.R. 1977 No. 196)

The Regulations, which supersede the Condensed Milk Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1961 (S.R. & O. (N.I.) 1961

No. 31) and the Dried Milk Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1965 (S.R. & O. (N.I.) 1965 No. 44) implement Council Directive 76/118/E.E.C. on the harmonisation of the laws of Member States relating to certain partly or wholly dehydrated preserved milk for human consumption. The Regulations—

- (a) define and lay down compositional requirements for certain condensed and dried milk products and restrict retail sales to these products;
- (b) prescribe reserved descriptions for such products;
- (c) require condensed milk and dried milk products when sold in containers to be labelled with reserved descriptions and specified declarations and prescribe the manner of marking and labelling to be employed;
- (d) prohibit, with certain specified exceptions, the application of reserved descriptions to other products;
- (e) introduce specific controls over the use of food additives in the products covered;
- (f) make consequential amendments to the Labelling of Food Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1970 (S.R. & O. (N.I.) 1970 No. 80), as amended.

The Regulations will come fully into operation on 1st July 1978 but provision has been made to allow products to be freely sold from 5th September 1977 if they comply with the new Regulations. The 1961 and 1965 Regulations will be revoked on 1st July 1980.

GAME PRESERVATION ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1928 AND GAME LAW AMENDMENT ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1951

4. the sale or purchase of hen pheasants for consumption in Northern Ireland or elsewhere at any time from 1st October, 1977 to 30th September, 1978 inclusive, except hen pheasants killed by a person exempted under paragraph 3, which may be sold to a licensed game dealer.

Persons seeking exemption under paragraph 3 above should apply to the Department of the Environment, Conservation Branch, Stormont, Belfast BT4 3SS.

STATUTORY RULES OF NORTHERN IRELAND

ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

1977 No. 227

*Restriction of Traffic (Routes B35, DR 1104 and DR 1105)
Order (Northern Ireland) 1977*

Made 27th July, 1977

Coming into operation 31st August, 1977

Whereas the Department of the Environment (in this Order referred to as "the Department") is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on the lengths of road described in the Schedule by reason of works proposed to be executed;

And whereas the Department has had regard to the existence of alternative routes suitable for traffic which will be affected;

Now therefore the Department in exercise of the power conferred by Section 22 of the Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland) 1970 (a) and now vested in it (b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby orders as follows:

1. This Order may be cited as the Restriction of Traffic (Routes B35, DR1104 and DR1105) Order (Northern Ireland) 1977 and shall come into operation on 31st August 1977.
2. (1) Subject to Paragraph (2) the use of those lengths of road described in the Schedule by any class or description of vehicles is prohibited for a period of five months from 30th August 1977.
2. (2) Paragraph (1) shall not apply to the use of the said lengths of road by vehicles requiring access to premises or lands within their length or to vehicles engaged in the works being executed.
