NOTES:

- The following diseases were eradicated from Northern Ireland in the years indicated: Cattle plague or rinderpest (*pestis bovina*) 1877; foot-and-mouth disease (*fièvre aphteuse*) 1941; glanders (including farcy) (*malleus*) 1913; parasitic mange (*sarcoptes scabiei equi*) 1946; pleuro-pneumonia (*pleuro-pneumonia contagiosa bovum*) 1893; rabies (*rage*) 1923; sheep pox (*variola ovina*) 1850; and swine fever (*peste porcine*) 1958.
- The following diseases have never been recorded in Northern Ireland: Swine vesicular disease, African horse sickness (*peste equorum*), African swine fever (*peste suum africana*), blue tongue (*febris catarrhalis ovium*), dourine (*exanthema coitale paralyticum*), equine encephalomyelitis (*meningo-encephalomyelitis enzootica eq*), equine infectious anaemia (*anaemia infectiosa equorum*), lumpy skin disease (*dermatosis nodularis*), Teschen disease (*encephalomyelitis enzootica suum*), epizootic lymphangitis (*lymphangitis epizootica*) and fowl plague (*peste avium*).

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
