#### THE IMPORTED FOOD (NORTHERN IRELAND) REGULATIONS 1968

##### *Austria: Official Certificate*

The Department of Health and Social Services, with the approval of the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, gives notice that, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Imported Food (Northern Ireland) Regulations 1968, it hereby restricts recognition of the Official Certificate reproduced in the First Schedule to the Notice published in the Belfast Gazette dated 3rd January 1969 for the importation of meat and meat products into Northern Ireland from Austria, to the extent shown in the Schedule hereto.

The Notice published in the Belfast Gazette dated 16th January 1976 is hereby revoked.

##### NOTE

*Imports of meat and meat products (including poultry meat) into Northern Ireland are restricted or prohibited under Diseases of Animals legislation by the Department of Agriculture, and applications for such importations must be made to that Department. Official Certificates for public health purposes in accordance with the Imported Food (Northern Ireland) Regulations 1968 do not confer any exemptions from these restrictions or prohibitions.*

### ROADS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1948

The Department of the Environment hereby gives notice of its intention to make an Order under Section 17 of the Roads Act (Northern Ireland) 1948, the effect of which would be to authorise the Department to stop-up to vehicular traffic the junction of the Craigadick Road (Route UR53) with the northern side of Route A6 in the townland of Craigadick, County Londonderry.

### ROAD TRAFFIC ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1970

The Department of the Environment has made a Statutory Rule under Sections 117, 117c and 189 of the Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland) 1970 entitled the Motor Cars (Driving Instruction) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1978 (S.R. 1978 No. 76).

These Regulations, which come into operation on 28th April 1978, further amend the Motor Cars (Driving Instruction) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1974. The requirement that an applicant for registration as an Approved Driving Instructor or an applicant for a "trainee" licence must have held a full driving licence for at least four of the six years preceding the date of his application has been modified so that any period for which he held a provisional licence and a driving test pass certificate may be counted towards the four years.
