DEPARTMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENT

Notice is hereby given that the Department of the Environment for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 44(4) of the Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland) 1970 and of all other enabling powers made on 5th September, 1978, an Order entitled Roads (Temporary Speed Limit) (Belfast-Newtownards Road) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1978 (SR 1978 No. 258) which will come into operation on 1st October, 1978.

This Order continues in force the provisions of the Roads (Temporary Speed Limit) (Belfast-Newtownards Road) Order (Northern Ireland) 1977 prohibiting the driving of vehicles on part of the Belfast-Newtownards Road, Co. Down, at more than 40 mph for a further period of four months from 1st October, 1978.

GAME PRESERVATION ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1928 AND GAME LAW AMENDMENT ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1951

Notice is hereby given that the Department on 19th July, 1978, made an Order under the above-mentioned Acts entitled:—The Game Preservation (Grouse, Partridge and Hen Pheasants) Order (Northern Ireland) 1978 (SR (N.I.) 1978 No. 199).

This Order prohibits:

1. the sale or purchase of grouse for consumption in Northern Ireland or elsewhere at any time from 12th August, 1978, to 11th August, 1979 inclusive;
2. the shooting or taking of partridge at any time from 1st October, 1978, to 30th September, 1979 inclusive;
3. the killing of hen pheasants at any time from 1st October, 1978, to 30th September, 1979 inclusive, except where exemption is granted;
4. the sale or purchase of hen pheasants for consumption in Northern Ireland or elsewhere at any time from 1st October, 1978, to 30th September, 1979 inclusive, except hen pheasants killed by a person exempted under paragraph 3, which may be sold to a licensed game dealer.

Persons seeking exemption under paragraph 3 above should apply to the Department of the Environment, Conservation Branch, Stormont, Belfast, BT4 3SS.
