WIDOWS', ORPHANS', AND OLD AGE CONTRIBUTORY PENSIONS ACT, 1925.

NOTICE is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the National Health Insurance Joint Committee and the Minister of Health, acting jointly in conjunction with His Majesty's Treasury and the Postmaster-General, after the expiration of at least 40 days from this date, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by the proviso to sub-section (1) of Section 28 and sub-section (1) of Section 30 of the Widows', Orphans', and Old Age Contributory Pensions Act, 1925, to make Regulations for amending the Contributory Pensions (Claims and Payment) Regulations, 1927;

And that on account of urgency the National Health Insurance Joint Committee and the Minister of Health, acting jointly in conjunction with His Majesty's Treasury and the Postmaster-General under Section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, made regulations entitled the Contributory Pensions (Claims and Payment) Amendment Regulations, 1928, to come into force immediately as Provisional
