STATUTORY RULES OF NORTHERN IRELAND 1979 No. 17

Road Traffic and Vehicles

Restriction of Traffic (Route DR 8c, Kilnasaggart Road)
Order (Northern Ireland) 1979

Made	19th January, 1979
Coming into operation	26th February, 1979

Whereas the Department of the Environment (in this Order referred to as "the Department") is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on the length of road described in the schedule by reason of works proposed to be executed;

And Whereas the Department has had regard to the existence of alternative routes suitable for traffic which will be affected;

Now Therefore the Department in exercise of the powers conferred by section 22 of the Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a) and now vested in it (b) and of every

other power enabling it in that behalf hereby orders as follows:

1. This Order may be cited as the Restriction of Traffic (Route DR-8c, Kilnasaggart Road) Order (Northern Ireland) 1979 and shall come into operation on 26th February, 1979.
2. (1) Subject to paragraph (2) the use of that length of road described in the schedule by any class or description of traffic is prohibited for a period of four months from 25th February, 1979.
- (2) Paragraph (1) shall not apply to the use of the said length of road by vehicles engaged in the works being executed.

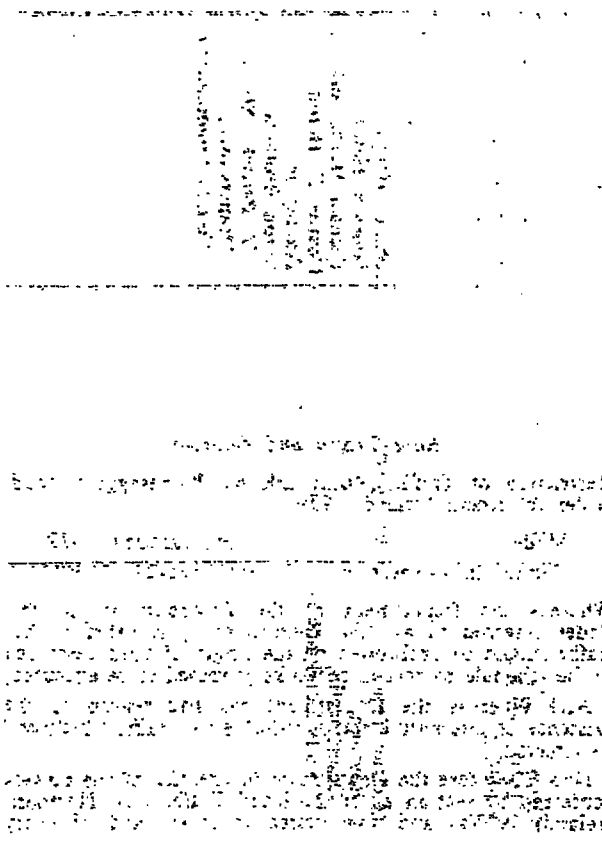
