- 1. This Order may be cited as the Restriction of Traffic (Route DR-8c, Kilnasaggart Road) Order (Northern Ireland) 1979 and shall come into operation on 26th February, 1979.
- 2. (1) Subject to paragraph (2) the use of that length of road described in the schedule by any class or description of traffic is prohibited for a period of four months from 25th February, 1979.
- (2) Paragraph (1) shall not apply to the use of the said length of road by vehicles engaged in the works being executed.
