WEIGHTS AND MEASURES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1967

Notice under Section 6

The Department of Commerce by this Notice hereby directs, pursuant to the provisions of section 6(6) of the Weights and Measures Act (Northern Ireland) 1967, as follows: Every certificate or authorisation, in existence in Great Britain at the date of publication of this Notice, which has been granted since 27th October, 1978, by the Department of Prices and Consumer Protection in Great Britain in respect of any pattern of weighing or measuring equipment for the purposes of section 12 of the Weights and Measures Act 1963 shall be deemed for the purposes of the Weights and Measures Act (Northern Ireland) 1967 to be a certificate of approval of that pattern or, as the case may be, an authorisation granted and published under section 6 of the said Act of 1967.

"Weights and Measures (Various Goods) (Termination of Imperial Quantities) Order (Northern Ireland)
(S.R. 1979 No. 197")

This Order which comes into force on 31st July, 1979, ends, on various dates, the permitted use of imperial quantities in the pre-packing of pasta, salt, cereal breakfast foods and oat products, dried vegetables, flour and flour products, biscuits and shortbread, edible fats, tea and dried fruits.

After the several dates shown in the Schedule to the Order these goods must be pre-packed in prescribed metric quantities.

THE IMPORTED FOOD (NORTHERN IRELAND) REGULATIONS 1968

Federal Republic of Germany: Official Certificate

The Department of Health and Social Services with the approval of the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State for Wales, gives notice that in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Imported Food (Northern Ireland) Regulations 1968 as amended by the Imported Food (Northern Ireland) (Amendment) Regulations 1973 hereby recognises the Official Certificates of the designs shown in the First Schedule hereto for the importation of poultry meat from the Federal Republic of Germany as showing:

- (i) that the poultry meat to which it relates was derived from poultry inspected before and after

death in the country of origin of the poultry meat and passed in accordance with criteria satisfactory to the Minister and the Secretary of State for Wales; and

- (ii) that the dressing, packing and other preparation of the poultry meat was carried out with all necessary precautions for the prevention of danger to health.

Recognition of the Official Certificates is restricted to the extent shown in the Second Schedule.

The Notices published in the Belfast Gazette dated 21st February, 1975, and 6th January, 1978, are hereby revoked.

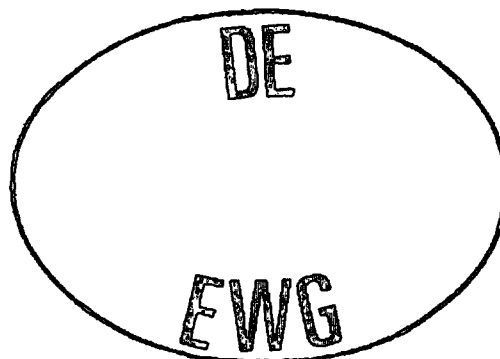
