

**NORTHERN IRELAND LAND ACT, 1925.
GUARANTEED 4½ PER CENT. BONDS.

NORTHERN IRELAND.**

KING'S BENCH DIVISION—IN BANKRUPTCY.

JAMES MC. C. SMYTH, of 80 High Street, in the City of Belfast, Flour Merchant, was on the 25th day of August, 1928, adjudged Bankrupt.
