### DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE

#### ADMINISTRATION OF ESTATES (1979 ORDER) (COMMENCEMENT No. 2) ORDER (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1980

The Secretary of State in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 1(2) of the Administration of Estates (Northern Ireland) Order 1979 has made a statutory rule entitled the Administration of Estates (1979 Order) (Commencement No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 1980. (S.R. 1980 No. 166). This rule appoints 1st June, 1980, as the date on which the remainder of the provisions, with two very minor exceptions, of the Administration of Estates (Northern Ireland) Order 1979 shall come into operation. Article 41 of that Order had come into operation on 1st March, 1980.

#### *Poultry Testing (Amendment) Scheme (Northern Ireland)* 1980
