NORTHERN IRELAND COURT SERVICE

Notice is hereby given that the Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 74(4)(a) and 117(1) of the Judgments (Enforcement) Act (Northern Ireland) 1969, has made a Statutory Rule entitled the Judgments Enforcement (Attachment of Earnings - Employer's Deduction) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1980 (S.R. 1980 No. 343). These Rules, which come into operation on 1st December, 1980, increase from 13p to 50p the additional amount which an employer making a deduction from a debtor's earnings under an attachment of earnings order may take towards his clerical and administrative costs.
