POLICE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1970

Notice is hereby given that the Royal Ulster Constabulary Pensions (Lump Sum Payments to Widows) Regulations 1980 (SR 1980 No. 351) have been made by the Secretary of State for Northern Ireland.

The order amends the Registration Rules in Schedule 3 to the Electoral Law Act (Northern Ireland) 1962.

Article 3(1) allows the Chief Electoral Officer to make special provision for the recording in the register of electors of certain categories of service voters.

Article 3(2) provides for the Chief Electoral Officer to correct the register of electors to include the name of a person whose name was not included in the register as published but who is entitled to be registered. It prescribes the procedure for making claims for inclusion and requires the Chief Electoral Officer to give notice of such claims and to determine the claims and any objections made thereto. It also confers a right of appeal against the decision of the Chief Electoral Officer to make or not to make an alteration in the register of electors as published.

Medicines Act 1968 that the Amendment to Volume III of the European Pharmacopoeia set out in the schedule hereto, which was adopted by the European Pharmacopoeia Commission on 22nd March, 1979, and published in accordance with the Convention of the Elaboration of a European Pharamacopoeia, is to have effect for the pur-poses of the said Section 65.

Glycerolum (Glycerol)

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page 231 Replace the paragraph entitled 'Reducing substances' by the following:

'Aldehydes and related substances. Introduce 12.5 ml of Solution S into a glass-stoppered flask. Add 2.5 ml of water and 1 ml of decolourised fuchsin solution R.

- Close the flask and allow to stand for 1 h. Any violet
- colour of the solution is not more intense than that
- of a reference solution obtained by mixing 1.6 ml of 0.1N potassium permanganate and 250 ml of water (method II, Vol. 1, page 59)'.

(This notice is to correct a notice published on 21st December, 1979, so far as it concerned Glycerolum, the quantity of 0.IN potassium permanganate having been stated incorrectly in the early notice.)

MISUSE OF DRUGS ACT 1971 - SECTION 12

Direction Prohibiting Exercise of Powers in Relation to Controlled Drugs

Now, therefore, in pursuance of section 12 of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971 I hereby direct that the said Nicholas Draper be prohibited from having in his possession, presupplying administering, manufacturing, compounding and supplying and from authorising the administration and supply of any controlled drug within the meaning of that Act.

This Direction does not extend to the doing of anything in circumstances in which it might lawfully be done without being a dentist.

ULSTER SAVINGS CERTIFICATES

Ulster Savings Certificates (Amendment) Regulations 1980

The Department of Finance has made regulations (Statutory Rules 1980 No. 369) prescribing the terms of a new Second Index Linked Issue of Ulster Savings Certificates and amending certain provisions of the principal regulations relating to Ulster Savings Certificates.

Second Index Linked Certificates will be put on sale on 17th November, 1980 and Index Linked Retirement Issue will be withdrawn at close of business on 15th November, 1980. The purchase price of a unit certificate will be $\pounds 10$ and the maximum permitted holding will be 300 units ($\pounds 3000$) which is in addition to the maxima of certificates of previous Issues. Certificates may be purchased by any person who has reached 60 years of age.

The value of these new Certificates will be calculated at repayment date in accordance with the movement of the Retail Price Index as issued monthly by the Department of Employment.

The Department of Health and Social Services with the approval of the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State for Wales gives notice that, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Imported Food (Northern Ireland) Regulations, 1968 as amended by the Imported Food (Northern Ireland) (Amendment) Regulations 1973 and 1979, it hereby recog-nises, subject to the conditions hereafter set out, the Official Certificates of which particulars are given in the Schedule hereto as showing: Schedule hereto as showing:

(a) that the meat to which they relate, or the meat from which the meat product to which they relate was prepared, and derived from mammals, inspected before and after death in the country of origin and passed in accordance with criteria satisfactory to the Minister, and . :

(b) that the dressing, packing and other preparation of the meat or the meat product was carried out with all necessary precautions for the prevention of danger to health.

1. Recognition of the Official Certificates is extended to include:

Portions of carcases, with or without bone, comprising recognisable wholesale or retail cuts which contain no associated lymphatic gland, or from which has been removed in preparing or trimming the meat any pleura, peritoneum or lymphatic gland.

Recognition does not extend to boneless veal appearing to an authorised officer to be from calves less than three months old.

- 2. The said Certificates are recognised subject to the following conditions:
- (a) This recognition applies to meat and meat products imported from South Africa.
- (b) Where the Official Certificates are in the form of stamps, recognition will apply only if the stamp is clearly impressed or otherwise marked on the meat or the meat product and the package containing the meat or the meat product.
 - (c) Where the Official Certificates are in the form of labels, the recognition will apply only if the labels are securely affixed to the meat or the meat product and the package containing the meat or meat product,
- and if the labels have not in any other circumstances or on any other occasion been used as Official Certificates.



The Health Ministers, that is to say the Secretaries of State respectively concerned with health in England, in Wales and in Scotland and the Department of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland, hereby declare, in accordance with section 65(8) of the Medicines Act 1968, that the Medicines Commission has approved, as a synonym for a name in the left-hand column of the list set out below (being a name at the head of a monograph set out below (being a name at the head of a monograph in the European Pharmacopoeia), the name or names corresponding to it in the right-hand column of that list, with or without any of the following modifications:

- (a) a change in the order of the words in the right-hand column, with the addition of a preposition if necessary:
- (b) the use of the syllables "sulf" and "cef" instead of, respectively, "sulph" and "ceph";
