

adjusted as to prevent the safe working load at the corresponding radius of the jib being exceeded. These valves shall be of sound construction and properly maintained.

(b) provided that for the purpose of making tests the relief valves may be adjusted to permit the safe working load to be exceeded by such amount as a competent person appointed to carry out the tests may authorise. (c) the hydraulic system shall be fitted with a correct pressure gauge indicating the pressure in pounds per square inch, which shall be of adequate size for the purpose, of sound construction and properly maintained. The gauge shall be in such position as to be easily visible to the person operating the crane. The pressure at which the relief valve operates to prevent the safe working load from being exceeded shall be marked on the dial of the gauge in a distinctive colour.

2. This Order may be cited as the Building Societies (Authorised Banks) (No. 99) Order 1980.
